NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 conducted public hearings on <u>August 29, 2013</u> and <u>September 5, 2013</u> on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by <u>3.31</u> percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of $\underline{\$0.10}$ for each \$100 of taxable value was \$5,995,694.00.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of $\underline{\$0.10}$ for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is $\underline{\$6,174,671.00}$.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of $\underline{\$0.10}$ for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$6,331,007.00.
