

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 conducted public hearings on September 1, 2016 and September 8, 2016 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 15.1 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.0958 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$7,853,641.00.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$9,022,409.00.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.1000 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$9,366,710.00.

The Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 15, 2016 at the District Headquarters, 201 East Pecan Street, Pflugerville, Texas at 6:00 p.m.

The Travis County Emergency Services District No. 2 proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of providing emergency services, including fire suppression and emergency medical services.
